

TRAINS AND BUSSES:

In the area around Copenhagen the bus and train system operates with zones.

In kiosks and at stations you can buy 10-trip cards, for 2,3,4,5,6 or all (if there is 7 or more) zones or single end return tickets (this is about double price). You stamp the card either in the bus or on the platform at the train station. There is a minimum of 2 zones per trip (also if you only travel in one.) From Copenhagen to Høje-Taastrup (which is the stop for VTC – Wednesday evening) there is all zones.

Hotel Clarion:

From the Airport to **Hotel Clarion**:

A taxi costs about 15 €, Or else there are 3 zones with public transportation.

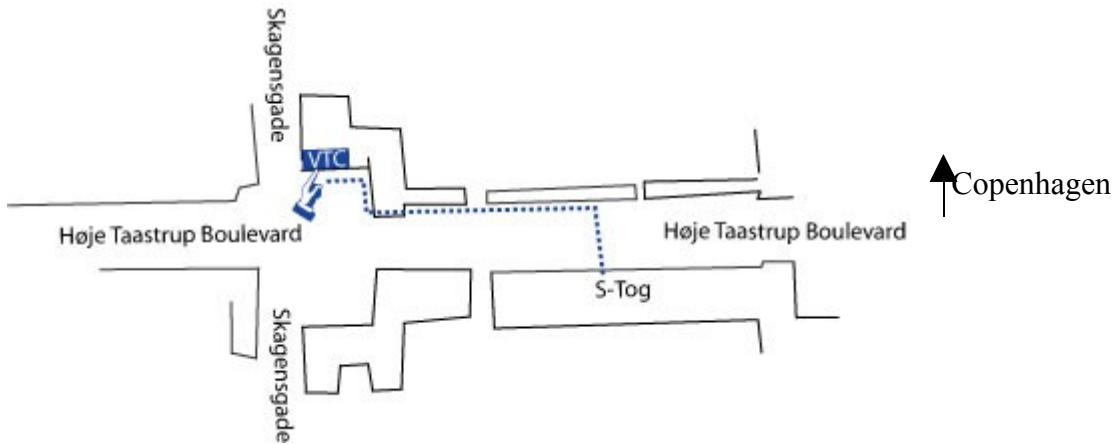
You take the train towards København H (the central station), Nivå or Helsingør and get off at Tårnby (first stop).

From here you take bus no. 30, to the stop called Bådehavnsgade, and you walk from here to the hotel.



From Clarion to VTC:

You go to the same busstop as above, and take bus 4A towards Svanemøllen and get off at Valby Station. From here you take the s-train B or B+ towards høje-tåstrup, and get off at the final station. The train departs every 10 minutes from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. and after that every 20 minutes. There are all zones.



From Clarion to centre of town:

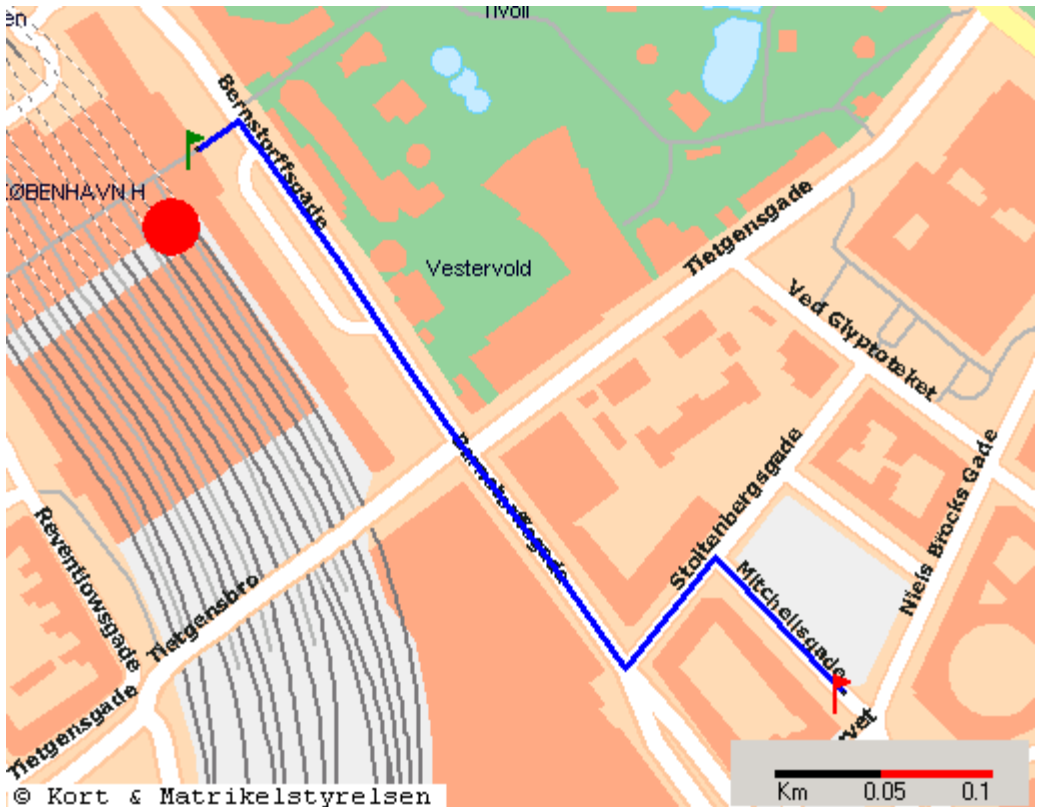
You take bus no. 30 from the same busstop as above, and there are 2 zones with public transport.

Cab Inn City:

From the Airport to **Hotel Cab Inn City:**

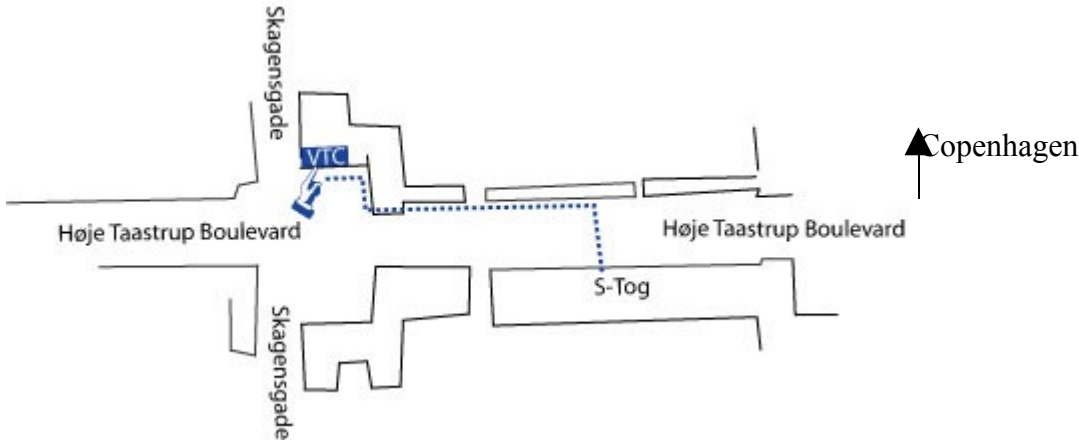
A taxi costs about 20 €, Or else there are 3 zones with public transportation.

You take the train towards København H (the central station), Nivå or Helsingør and get off at København H (third stop). From here you walk from to the hotel.



From Cab Inn City to VTC

You walk to the central station and take the s-train B or B+ towards Høje-Tåstrup, and get off at the final station. The train departs every 10 minutes from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. and after that every 20 minutes. There are all zones.
